A/Prof Sue Liew - Orthopaedic Surgery

My back/hip/knee/shoulder hurts... What's new?



A/Professor Susan Liew is an orthopaedic and spine surgeon and Head of the Orthopaedic Unit. She has worked at the Alfred since 2007 and also works at the Royal Childrens' Hospital. Her clinical interests are spine trauma and spine deformity. She has been involved a number of Department of Health projects regarding “Low Values Surgeries” and “Models of Care” particularly in the areas of the management of diseases of the spine & the knee. At the hospital level her team have developed a number of different practice guidelines and alternative assessment pathways (eg physio-led clinics) to try to enable more efficient throughput of our referrals from the community.

Dr Dane Holden - Burns Unit

Burns – What, Where and How



Dr Dane Holden is a recently appointed full time Burns surgeon at the Alfred Health ‘Victorian Adult Burns Service’. He has a background in General Surgery and has a special interest in Education. He holds a Master of Surgery (University of Sydney) and a Master of Surgical Education (University of Melbourne). Each year, over 5,000 patients present to Emergency Departments throughout Victoria with burn injuries. Approximately 400 of these injuries are transferred to the states' two specialist burns services at the Alfred and Royal Children's Hospital for specialist care.

Mr David J Morgan is a Specialist Plastic Surgeon and current Head of the Facio-maxillary Surgery Unit at The Alfred Hospital. The unit primarily manages acute facial trauma, the correction of secondary facial deformities, and the ongoing management of congenital craniofacial deformities. He has previously been the National Chairman of the Board of Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery and member of the RACS Board of Surgical Education and Training, and is currently a Council Member of the Australian Society of Plastic Surgeons.
